All employees are subject to daily temperature checking via medically approved infrared thermometers. Instruction issued to temperature checkers: • The thermometer is infrared; non-contact • Face mask to be worn • Nitrile gloves to be worn • Nitrile gloves to be worn • The person to be checked faces away from the checker. • The thermometer is sanitised with sanitizing wipes Visitors/Contractors attending site are prohibited unless business critical. If deemed necessary, all visitors/Contractors will be required to use the hand sanitizing or hand washing facilities provided before proceeding. Face to face meetings suspended to maintain 2 metre distancing policy Delivery drivers and hauliers will be required to remain in their vehicle or if they cannot then are required to use the hand sanitizing or hand washing facilities provided before proceeding. Any visitor, contractor, delivery driver or haulier who appears to be unwell will not be permitted entry. 2 metre distancing strictly adhered to unless business critical. Floor markings give a visual guide to 2 metre distancing throughout all assembly areas. Signage is posted in all work areas reminding all employees of the requirements of good hand santising practices and the 2 metre distancing requirements. 2 metre distancing requirement communicated via Pandemic Safety Measures document and infographic. For tasks where there is a requirement to work within 2 metres employees are issued with face visors, masks and gloves. Instruction given to use of PPE. Face masks and gloves are disposable; face shields can be sanitised with sanitizing wipes. The sharing of PPE is not permitted. Dedicated PPE disposal bins placed at exit points. Delivery drivers and hauliers will be required to remain in their vehicle or if they cannot then required to use the hand sanitizing or hand washing facilities provided before proceeding. Any visitor, contractor, delivery driver or haulier who appears to be unwell will not be permitted entry. Due to the nature of the products components delivered are rarely handled within 72 hours of manufacture. Once delivered products are also stored in warehouse locations until required. Users of pool cars are to sanitise steering wheel and controls before commencing their journey. If it is absolutely necessary to carry a passenger then all employees involved must wear a mask and gloves. This PPE is disposed of immediately on arrival. Driver and passenger must sit at the maximum distance possible in the vehicle and open windows to give good ventilation. Sales representatives role suspended with representative furloughed until it is safe to visit customers. Company delivery drivers delivering products are to adhere to the Company's Covid-19 safety requirements detailed in this risk assessment as a minimum; any requirement for additional measures by the customer will also be adhered to.
