

ELECTRA® BIN Operator Instruction Leaflet

IMPORTANT NOTE: ENSURE THAT ALL RELEVANT PERSONNEL READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS PRIOR TO USE

To Open.





Using the triangular-shaped key provided, turn the key anti-clockwise to unlock the door. The door is fitted with a magnetic strip to help retain the door when unlocked.

The magnet will take a small amount of force to override. The magnet is designed to keep the door shut whilst the liner / refuse sack is emptied.

To Empty and Replace Solid Liner.



Slide the liner out of the bin by pulling on the liner handle.



Lift the liner inside the bin and rest it on the internal shelf using the liner handle.

To Secure a Sack in Position (Sack Retention Model).





Pull the rear sack band upwards.



Drop the sack down through the sack bands.



Press the edges of the bag over the edge of the sack bands. Press the rear sack band downwards to add tension and secure the sack in place.



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Push the sack retention system back inside the bin.



Close the door and lock the bin using the triangular key, turning the key clockwise.

To Empty and Replace the Ashtray Liner.



Open the bin (as shown in diagrams 1-2) and remove main bin liner or pull the sack retention forwards. Lift Ashtray from brackets and remove from the bin.

Empty Ashtray liner and replace by hooking back onto the brackets.

To Assemble the Freestanding Base (60L Model)

ITEM 1 - Free Standing Base Kit ITEM 2 - M10 Screw ITEM 3 - M10 Washer ITEM 4 - M10 Nut



Place the Free Standing Base on the ground, with the pre-fixed screws protruding upwards.

Place the Electra Litter Bin on the Free Standing Base and align holes in the base of the bin with the four screws.

Secure in position using the M10 washer [ITEM 3] and M10 Nut [ITEM 4] and tighten using an M10 Spanner.



Ensure the base is secured in position and place in an appropriate location.

To Install the Litter Bin (Ground Fixing).

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KIT CONTENTS:

ITEM 1 - Anchor Rawl Plug x 4 ITEM 2 - Screw (M10 x 60mm) x 4 ITEM 3 - M10 x 50mm Washer x 4

TOOLS REQUIRED:

Marker Pen Drill with Ø16mm Masonry Drill Bit Hammer 17mm Socket Set or 17mm Spanner Lubricant or Grease



Place the bin in the desired location. Inspect the condition of the concrete you wish to install in to. If installing into paving slabs- ensure fixings are not positioned within 110mm of the edge of a slab (as doing so may cause the slab to break).



Mark the positions of the four ground fixing holes in the base of the bin onto the concrete base below using a marker pen.



Move the bin to one side to allow the holes to be drilled. Ensure the holes are clearly visible.



Place the bin back into position. Take care to align the ground fixing holes.



Using a powerful drill - drill the four 16mm diameter fixing holes to a minimum depth of 80mm. Afterwards, take care to ensure the concrete dust is removed from the holes using an air blower or sweeping brush.



Take the M10 Screws (ITEM 2) and Washers (ITEM 3) and fit them through the base of the bin and into the ground anchor sleeves fit- (maximum recommended torque ted into the concrete.



Take the four Anchor Rawl Plugs (ITEM 1) and using a hammer gently tap them into the four ground fixing holes.



Tighten the M10 Screws using a Socket Wrench fitted with a17mm Socket or 17mm Spanner setting is 40Nm).

Lubricant or Grease.

Concrete Mix.

Spirit Level.

Equipment to excavate hole.

17mm Socket Set or 17mm Spanner.

To Install the Litter Bin (Concrete-In).

Prepare a hole.

- Electra 60L- 500mm long, 350mm wide, 400 deep.
- Electra 85L- 500mm long, 500mm wide, 400mm deep.

Fill the base with an 80mm deep layer of fine gravel. Place support blocks under the positions where the concrete fixings will rest at the

base of the hole.



Fit the bin into the hole to test the depth and level of the hole. Adjust the support blocks and depth of the gravel until the base supports the bin so that the base sits level with the ground surface and is vertically level.



Lay the bin on its back

(onto a soft surface which

will not cause damage to

the product). Attach the

four concrete fixings (ITEM

4) through the ground fixing

holes as shown. Use a 17mm

Spanner or Socket Wrench to

secure.

Use a spirit level to check the alignment in all orientations.
