


OPERATIONAL INSTRUCTIONS


NEXUS 100 CUP RECYCLING STATION




OPENING DOOR / CHECKING FILL LEVEL OF CUP STACKERS



Using the finger lip at the front of the lid, lift the lid upwards.




Lift the lid to the upright position until the lid is held by the stay feature.



Tilt the door forward until the door is held in the open position.

REMOVING / EMPTYING THE CUP STACKERS WITH NO BAG




Remove each cup stacker from the bar at the rear of the bin body.




To remove the cups, move the quick release 45 degrees to the right.


REMOVING / EMPTYING THE LIQUID RESERVOIR, WASTE LINER & DRIP TRAY



Remove the left side pod lid.




Remove the reservoir using the handle on the top, remove from the side pod to empty.




Use the spout to ensure the reservoir is emptied easily and neatly.




The reservoir has a large opening and is easily cleaned with warm soapy water.




Return the reservoir and lid to complete the emptying procedure.




Remove the right side pod lid.



Remove the 8ltr liner for emptying and cleaning.



Return the liner and lid to complete the emptying procedure.



The door comes complete with a drip tray to collect any spills and is removable for ease of cleaning.


INSERTING A SACK WITHIN THE BIN BODY




Lift the lid to the upright position until the lid is held by the stay feature.




Tilt the door open. Remove each cup stacker from the steel bar at the rear of the bin.




Rest each cup stacker against the rear side of the door within the drip tray.



Place the sack inside of the bin resting one half of the sack on the steel bar.



Place each cup stacker within the sack resting them on the steel bar.




Ensure the sack is held within the bin body, close the door and lid to secure the sack in place.

EMPTYING CUPS WITH A SACK IN THE BIN BODY










until the lid is held by the stay feature.

Lift the lid to the upright position Lift the cup stacker from the steel bar.

To remove the cups, move the quick release 45 degrees to the right. Rest the empty cup stacker inside the drip tray.







Remove the bagged stacks of cups for recycling. Refer to steps 15-20 to place a new sack in the bin
